How well do you think your child has settled at nursery?





What does this tell us?


84% of families who responded scored their child's settling at nursery as a 5.

16% scored it at a 4.

0% scored it at a 1, 2 or 3.

16% scored it at a 4


0% scored it at 1, 2 or 3.

95% of families who responded scored the conduct of staff as welcoming and approachable as a 5.


5% scored is at a 4

Are you accessing the Tapestry online learning journal?





Do you feel you are informed about your child's learning through Tapestry?





5% scored it at a 2.


2% scored it at a 1.

What does this tell us?

51% of families who responded scored our home learning opportunities as a 5.

40% scored it at a 4.

7% scored it at a 3.

2% scored it at a 2.

We are really pleased that so many of you were able to engage in such a positive way with the home learning we offered at such a challenging time. We are delighted that all of the children have now returned to nursery and can take part in our curriculum first hand again.

Do you feel your child has made progress in their communication skills, maths skills, physical skills and their early reading and writing skills?





What does this tell us?

65% of families who responded scored the progress their child has made as a 5.

19% scored it at a 4.

12% scored it at a 3.

2% scored it at a 2.

2% scored it at a 1.

Our assessment data and observations show us that the children have made significant progress in all areas from their individual starting points. Moving forward, we will develop how this progress is shared with you through Tapestry and through the termly written reports we give to you.

Shenley Fields is a Unicef Rights Respecting School. How confident are you talking to your child about their rights?





68% of families who responded scored their confidence in talking to their child about their rights as a 5.

21% scored it at a 4.


7% scored it at a 3.

88% of families who responded scored their confidence in our following of the Covid 19 government guidelines as a 5.

5% scored it as a 4.

7% scored it as a 3.

We are glad that so many of you are reassured by the measures we have taken which include separate entrances/exits for each of our provisions, staggered start and finish times for the children, limiting the number of people in the building, robust and thorough cleaning regimes and separation of the staff teams to minimise the risk of spreading any infection. We need to continue working together to keep our school community as safe as we can.

Are the new noticeboards outside your child's entrance to nursery useful? Please let us know what information you would like to see included on these boards.




