

Dear Parents and Carers

From Monday 22nd June 2020 we are dividing children into different groups (bubbles) that do not mix. Each group is accessed via its own drop off point (we are not permitting parents and carers to enter any part of the building).

Yellow Bubble Arrivals: Health Entrance drop off/ collection (nearest to the mini roundabout)

Blue Bubble Arrivals: Nursery Entrance drop off/ collection (adjacent to the Primary School)

All access to the nursery must be on foot via the *nursery* car park entrance (which will be closed to all cars). Please see the videos on our website and social media pages for a visual guide to site drop off and collection. All communication with nursery will need to be via the telephone or email. If you are unsure where to drop off your child, please call us before setting out.

Our school day is currently 9:00am – 3:00pm. Please ensure you arrive and collect on time. We ask that only one parent/ carer comes onto site. All children will need to bring a packed lunch in a named box (unless it has been agreed that we are providing lunch). Please note that nursery will only provide sandwiches from 22.6.20 as we are advised to have picnic lunches outdoors wherever possible to reduce risk. Your child will also require a named drinks bottle, named hat and named bottle of sun cream. Please support your child to apply sun cream before they arrive at nursery.

Children are to wear their own clothes (not uniform) and wear sensible, sturdy footwear (shoes or trainers) with closed toes. Please do not allow your child to bring other items into nursery.

If you child is not well enough to attend, please inform us via telephone - (0121) 675 0362

If your child attends nursery, you will need to abide by our conditions of use. We will keep places under review at all times, especially if staffing levels decrease through illness or self-isolation.

Please talk the above changes through with your child to support their understanding of all the changes happening around them.

The following declaration needs to be completed for each child. Without this we will not be able to admit your child to nursery. Although we already hold some of this information, we realise that health needs may have changed and emergency contacts altered in light of the pandemic.

Provision

Statement:	Please tick
I appreciate that should it become impossible for Allens Croft Nursery	
School to staff the provision due to staff illness or self-isolation, then the	
provision will cease with immediate effect and that this may be with very	
little notice.	
I will park outside of nursery on the public road. I know I am not permitted	
to park in the car park at the current time.	
I will keep two metres away from other families waiting at the drop off and	
collection points.	
I will arrive at nursery at 9:00am and collect my child at 3:00pm.	
I understand that when dropping my child to nursery at 9:00am, I will wait	
outside the appropriate doorway (by the nursery school car park for	
children accessing the yellow 'bubble' of part-time places or alongside	
the primary school car park for children accessing the blue 'bubble' of	
full-time places).	
I understand that when dropping off or collecting my child, I will only	
access the nursery via the site entrance nearest to the mini-roundabout	



and follow the social distancing markers on the ground. Once I have collected my child, I will follow the one-way system past the front of the primary school in order to keep 2 metres away from other families at all times.	
My child must be wearing clean clothes (own clothes) when they arrive and have washed their hands before they enter the building.	
I understand that no parent/ carer will be allowed into the nursery building unless directed to do so by a member of staff.	
To maintain my child's place and ensure the safety of others, I understand that my family must carry out social distancing at all times. This means my child and our family (household) will only mix with other families in accordance with government advice and guidance. I will also not have unnecessary visitors in my home, so I can do all I can to ensure the virus does not spread.	

Health Risks

Statement:	Please tick
If my child has an underlying health condition, I will seek and act on the	
advice of their GP/ consultant/ midwife or current government advice.	
I understand that my child will be asked to wash their hands regularly	
throughout the school day and follow our hygiene rules and practices.	
I understand that nursery and parents/ carers need to undertake stringent	
practices to reduce the risks of transmission of the virus (and other	
illnesses).	
I understand that the adults working in nursery will try to maintain	
common sense in terms of social distancing whilst working with the	
children however, children of nursery age are not expected to keep 2	
metres apart in school. There are also times when our staff team will be	
in close contact with your child/ren.	
I understand that whilst nursery will endeavor to regularly clean the areas	
used and will engage in frequent hand washing, we are unable to	
guarantee a virus free school.	
I will ensure that my child has high levels of hygiene and cleanliness to	
reduce the risk of transmission	

Organistaion and Safety

Statement	Please tick
I understand that each group of children (bubble) will need to be self- contained for the school day; unable to mix or come close to any other groups	
groups. I understand that that each group ('bubble') has its own entrance and I	
will only use that drop off / collection point. I will contact the nursery by telephone, before travelling to nursery, if I am uncertain of which drop off	
point has been allocated to me.	

Clothing/ Personal Items

Statement	Please tick
I will ensure that my child is wearing clean clothes (own clothes) every day to reduce the risk of transmission of the virus. They should bring a named coat, a named packed lunch box (for those that provide their own lunch), a named drinks bottle and a named bottle of sun cream (preferably factor 50+) every day. Please also apply sun cream to your	
child's skin before arrival.	
My child will not bring any items other to nursery from home.	



Medication / Illness

Statement	Please tick
I will not bring my child to the nursery premises if they have any	
symptoms of coronavirus or if anyone in the household has symptoms.	
This includes a temperature, a cough or a loss of taste or smell. I will	
isolate my child and the whole household for 7/14 days of this is the case	
and will inform nursery immediately. This means you should not leave the	
house. Your child cannot attend our provision in this time. This is also the	
case for any child with a cough, whatever the reason. We take no	
chances. We cannot afford to for the sake of your child, your family, our	
staff and the wider community.	
If a child or member of staff has coronavirus symptoms, they will need to	
be absent from nursery for 7 days and their household to self-isolate for	
14 days. Children and staff in nursery will have access to testing. Those	
absent with coronavirus symptoms will be able to return to nursery as	
soon as soon as they have a negative result or they have been through	
the correct period of self-isolation. Having a positive result and an	
absence due to coronavirus will have an impact on the rest of the group -	
we would need guidance from Public Health England about further	
control measures in this situation.	
If my child has medication for asthma, allergies or other conditions, I will	
ensure that nursery always has the required medication and ensure this	
is duplicated at home in case of the need to suddenly close nursery.	
I understand that if my child needs any other form of medication, I will	
need to complete a 'Medication Form' (available by asking a member of	
our team at the drop off points). Administration of medication will need to	
be agreed by the Executive Head Teacher / Head of School / Senior	
Leader on the day.	
I will inform a member of staff on arrival if I have given my child any	
medication e.g. Calpol, before they come to nursery. However, this	
cannot be for a temperature as they must self-isolate for 14 days if they	
have one.	
I understand that if my child becomes unwell during their time in nursery,	
they will be immediately placed in isolation until they are collected (in	
accordance with government guidance) and I will be contacted and	
asked to collect them urgently. If I cannot be reached, the other contracts	
given will be called. I understand that the nursery staff will not have to	
prove or justify their decision about a child's illness. We then have to take	
advise and if a deep clean is required ALL children could be sent home.	
I will ensure that nursery always has up to date contact details for both	
myself and my named emergency contacts.	
I will ensure that there is always at least one named person on my	
emergency contact list that is continuously contactable and immediately	
able to collect my child from nursery, if requested by our team.	
I understand that if my child falls ill, the staff team will contact medical	
services as well as contacting me.	
I understand the last day of this term at nursery will be Friday 17 th July	
2020. We are still ascertaining what provision will be available over the	
summer holiday.
