Did you know that we use Tapestry to share lots of information with you about our curriculum and the learning opportunities and experiences on offer to your child?

This includes:

- Our planning for each area of continuous provision both indoors and outdoors.
- Observations and photos of the activities detailed in our planning in action.
- The core book we are focusing on, including the key vocabulary we will be teaching.
- The song/rhyme we are focusing on from our Shenley Rhyme Time and how these enhance our planning for phonics and maths.

Library


Have you been to visit our library yet?

It is a lovely space to spend time with your child, with a great range of books to share and enjoy together. Every child has their own book bag to take the book they have chosen home.


Our school library will be open every day from 8am-9.30am.

We are very proud to be a Gold Rights Respecting School. We were first awarded gold status in January 2021 and maintained gold at our reaccreditation in January 2024.

We have a coat exchange scheme. Shenley Fields coat exchange aims to encourage us to recycle and donate coats that children have outgrown rather than putting them in the bin. Please bring in your unwanted coats and if your child needs a coat, please take one free of charge from inside the main entrance. When you no longer need it or your child grows out of it, bring it back and swap it for another coat.



We will keep you updated weekly on the focus of our rights respecting work.

Attendance

"Being in school is important to your child's achievement, wellbeing, and wider development." Evidence shows that the students with the highest attendance throughout their time in school gain the best GCSE and A Level results." (DfE)

To recognise and celebrate good attendance, each half term, we will give attendance certificates to every child who has at least 90% attendance (appointments for children with medical needs and SEND will not impact on this.)



We would love to give as many of these out as possible each half term.

CHILD SAFETY CONCERNS

The access that leads to our entrance is a private road intended for the shopkeepers, householders and garage owners. They share our concern regarding the volume of traffic using this access at busy times, which has led to a number of 'near misses' between cars and children.

Our advice is that cars are parked on the surrounding roads.

Alternatively, if you live within walking distance, leave your car at home and encourage your children to get into the habit of walking. A number of families do use the access road due to their personal circumstances with our knowledge and consent.


Inset Day:

Please can we ask that you do not bring the foods containing the following to nursery:

There are children at nursery who could become very poorly if they come into contact with these foods. Thank you.

Labelling your Child's Belongings - Please name your child's belongings - especially coats, bags and lunch boxes. We have lots of coats and bags that are the same.

Spare Clothes - Can you please send your child to nursery with a set of spare clothes in their bag and return any borrowed items as soon as possible.

Collection Timings:

Your child's day at nursery starts at 9am. Please make sure they are on time to enable them to make the very most of their day with us. If you arrive later than 9.10, you will need to take your child to our main reception.

Collection time is 3pm. If you have any circumstances which make this collection time difficult, then please discuss this with us.

Wednesdays are the only exception to this:

If your child's place is the beginning of the week, drop off is at 9am and collection at 12 midday.

If your child's place is at the end of the week, drop off is at 12.15 and collection at 3.15pm.

Drop off and collections outside of these times is hugely disruptive and impacts on the experiences on offer to the children.
