Noah’s Star is a charity that supports families of premature and sick babies.

Noah’s Star is a charity founded by Jo-Anne Shellum in 2017 which was officially registered in January 2021. Noah’s Star provide support and guidance for families with sick and preterm babies having to stay in the Neonatal Intensive Care Units (NICU’s) across the West Midlands. They provide support to the whole family, with a particular focus on providing support to the siblings.

Some of the most useful items for the families Noah’s Star supports in the Neonatal Units include:

- Children’s books (especially board books suitable for children)
- Notebooks or journals for parents to record their baby’s journey.
