CHILD SAFETY CONCERNS

Dear Mums, Dads and Carers

The access that leads to our entrance is a private road intended for the shopkeepers, householders and garage owners. They share our concern regarding the volume of traffic using this access at busy times, which has led to a number of 'near misses' between cars and children.

Our advice is that cars are parked on the surrounding roads.

Alternatively, if you live within walking distance, leave your car at home and encourage your children to get into the habit of walking.

A number of families do use the access road due to their personal circumstances with our knowledge and consent.

Library


Have you been to visit our library yet?

It is a lovely space to spend time with your child, with a great range of books to share and enjoy together. Every child has their own book bag to take the book they have chosen home.


Our school library will be open every day from 8am-9.30am.

You can use the library to share books with your child or just choose one to take home and enjoy together.


Your child can change their library book as frequently as they would like to. Just bring your book back and choose a new one.

We are very proud to be a Gold Rights Respecting School.

We had our reaccreditation visit on January 24th to check if we are still eligible to keep our Gold status. The assessor spent time with children and staff and engaged in activities during her visit. She also met with members of both our child and adult steering groups. We will know the outcome of this very soon so watch this space.....

We are reintroducing our coat exchange scheme. Shenley Fields coat exchange aims to encourage us to recycle and donate coats that children have outgrown rather than putting them in the bin. Please bring in your unwanted coats and if your child needs a coat, please take one free of charge from inside the main entrance. When you no longer need it or your child grows out of it, bring it back and swap it for another coat.

Thank you once again to everyone who donated so generously to our food bank collection. The Life House Centre in Selly Oak were overwhelmed with how much food we donated and the positive impact this had on local families in need of support, especially over the Christmas period.









Shenley Fields has taken part in this year's Big Garden Birdwatch. The children have really developed their knowledge and understanding of birds. They have

- Used binoculars and picture charts to observe and identify birds that visit our garden or fly overhead.
- Counted the birds they have seen to identify the most/least common.
- Engaged in research to find out what they like to eat and where they live.
- Made bird food to make sure they aren't hungry.

We are all delighted that we have been awarded a certificate to acknowledge our participation in the Big Garden Birdwatch.

Labelling your Child's Belongings - Please name your child's belongings; especially coats, bags and lunch boxes. We have lots of coats and bags that are the same.

Spare Clothes - Please send your child to nursery with a set of spare clothes in their bag and return any borrowed items as soon as possible.

Early Collection - Please allow us to remind you that if you need to collect your child early from nursery this is strictly by **booking only**. Doing so early without prior arrangement causes disruption to the children's end of day routine. Thank you.

Collection Timings - It is very important that your child is collected on time at the end of their nursery session. Being collected late has a negative impact upon children's emotional wellbeing. Please note that there is a late fee of £15 for every 10 minutes that you are late collecting your child.
